Auction is a **Cherry Wood Dining Table**, which could have sold for \$104
as Lot 1826. This table, in contrast to
options from big retailers, is constructed
from a beautiful cherry hardwood that
will withstand years of use and look
beautiful doing it. In contrast to other
options from big retail brands such as
IKEA or Asley furniture, this table is not
only constructed of solid wood, it
features a premium hardwood that will

easily exceed the appearance of pine or oak options. Additionally, this table features beautifully carved legs, three extra leaves to allow for easy expansion, and the peace of mind that comes with the table's reinforced leg structure. It is in excellent condition, with only a few surface imperfections that will quickly fade from perception as the table ages, perfect for the needs of a young couple or growing family alike.

Next up from the January Annex
Auction, Lot 2057, a Set of Four Black
Leather Seat Chairs which sold for
\$455. The four chairs feature an elegant
wood frame, which features a beautiful
grain pattern extending up the back of



the chair, and a black leather cushion that covers the seating area. Three horizontally placed rectangular cutouts provide air circulation and lighten the design. Each of the chair's four legs splay outwards beneath the leather seating cushion. The cushion is sewn with durable string in a handsome pattern and features smooth black leather. These chairs' excellent designs are signs of a remarkable designer, and similarly, well-designed chairs, such as the Betwixt Chair from Herman Miller cost \$380 for the four-chair set.
