Annex Highlights

First up is a Collection of

Japanese Imari Porcelain Plates, and Stand, which sold for \$80 in Michaan's Auction's February Annex Auction. This collection would form a great start to any household and includes many of the most used and popular dishes to begin hosting friends and family for dinner. This lot included two serving bowls and two sets of plates, totaling eleven dishes. The porcelain is

in excellent condition and boasts fine details, with elegant floral elements and bright glaze which contrast sharply against the white porcelain background. It also includes two stands for storing and displaying serving bowls when not in use, a thoughtful inclusion that makes these an even more excellent bargain for the careful buyer.

Service, which sold for \$160. This service includes a significant number of items, making it perfect for those who are looking for a complete matching set that will serve them over the long term.

This set includes both small and large plates, as well as soup bowls, and thirteen teacups and saucers. It includes several serving bowls, including two with covers, two platters, and three gravy boats. All the items have matching blue rims with golden embellishments which lend elegance to the purposeful

design on display. Each of these items is in excellent condition and will undoubtedly provide valuable service for years to come.

Finally is a **Set of Wedgwood** Ascot Tea Cups, Saucers, and **Plates**, which brought in bids reaching \$110 on the second day of our February Annex Auction. This lot featured eight teacups and saucers, six of which feature a widening lip, and two with the traditional vertical finish. Each cup features elegant handles that curve up at the end, allowing for easy handling. The lot also includes several salad plates, entrée plates, and extra saucers. Each item in the lot is in excellent condition, with a thick gold gilt edge that matches perfectly with each of the small golden rings at the center of the plate. This lot would be an excellent base for, or in addition to, a family's hosting dishware.



The items compare quite favorably against housewares from large retailers. A ten piece tea set will easily sell for over \$200 from a manufacturer of genuine porcelain such as Jonathan Adler. Meanwhile, a porcelain dinner dishware set will go for \$300 or more, especially if it features ornamentation or design work, and this does not include the cost of serving platters such as was included in several lots at Michaan's Auctions.
